First public hearing to receive comments from the public on the proposed annexation of 127.43 acres located west of city limits of Los Fresnos and measuring approximately 0.7324 miles, on the south side of West Hwy 100 from Tapis's Restaurant to existing city limits of Brownsville and on the north side of West Hwy 100 from Longhorn Lane to drainage ditch. No Action

Mayor Narvaez opened the public hearing at 6:05 PM.

Mr. Milum explained that the area we are proposing to annex is west of the existing city limits on West Highway 100. There is approximately 127.43 acres proposed to be annexed. On the south side of West Hwy 100 from Tapia's Restaurant west to the existing city limits of Brownsville and on the north side of West Hwy 100 from Longhorn Lane west to the drainage ditch. Mr. Milum had a map that showed the area to be annexed.

Consideration and ACTION to approve and adopt a Resolution to designate administration and engineering service providers for the 2016 Texas Community Development Block Grant Fund contracts. Adopted

Mr. Milum explained that CDBG selection of Administration and Engineer is a little different than our normal procedure. The rates paid are set by them and the prospective firms are pre-qualified by them. The rates are no more than 16% for Administration and no more than 20% for the Engineering. We sent out 8 proposals to different companies for Administration and only 1 proposal was received and that was from GrantWorks. We sent out 7 proposals to different firms for Engineering and we received 4 proposals. The Mayor appointed the rating committee and Naismith Engineering was the highest rated firm.

The grant is for street repairs on East 6th Street from Pita to Coma and on East 9th Street from South Arroyo to Pita.

Motion was made and seconded to approve GrantWorks for Administration and Naismith Engineering for Engineer and to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract.

Gary Minton made a motion to approve Consideration and ACTION to approve and adopt a Resolution to designate administration and engineering service providers for the 2016 Texas Community Development Block Grant Fund contracts., seconded by Swain Real the vote was [Unanimous].

Discussion on Hazardous Mitigation Plan. No Action

Mr. Milum explained that the different Hazard Mitigation Actions Plans to the Council. Discussed were Dam Failure, Drought, Expansive soils, Extreme Heat, Extreme Wind, Flood, Hail, Hazardous Material, Hurricane Wind, Pipeline Failure, Terrorism, Tornado, and Wildfire. There are two action plans for each category.

Council suggested to add generators and a gator pump.

- A. Wastewater Plant Expansion We are having a difficult time cutting down the scope of work in a way that saves substantial funds when compared to the needs. We will continue to work and hopefully have a direction in the next month or so.
- B. Nature Park the design of the park is continuing. We will have information and a public hearing in July or August to go over the concept and get your input.
- C. Hike & Bike Trails The preliminary drawings are done. The more specific items are being worked on including working with TxDot on the requirements for the crossings at FM 2480 and State Highway 100. Our engineers from Halff & Associates are working with both TxDot and Cameron County Drainage District #1 to agree on a preferred alignment. When we get further along we will bring it to the Council for review and comments.
- D. Memorial Park Playground Playground is open with lots of kids playing on it. It is a hugh success. We had the ribbon cutting on May 31.

- E. Certificates of Obligation There is no change from last month.
- F. Montes-Castro Park We meet with TPW for the initial visit to determine all the requirements. We will have to advertise for an engineering firm for the design of the park. We were hoping to do that ourselves and save that money but will not be able to. We will need a rating review committee.
- G. New Tractor Mr. Milum showed the Council a picture of the tractor.

Mr. Milum stated we will need a rating committee for the Whipple Road improvements and the Montes-Castro Park.

Mayor Pro-tem Mendez volunteered to serve on the Whipple Road Improvement Committee and Council Member Garza volunteered to serve on the Montes-Castro Park Committee.
