Mr. Milum explained during the design of the Hike & Bike Trail Project it was determined additional improvements would be needed which required additional funding a total of \$339,152.63. He contacted the Valley Baptist Legacy Foundation and they said they will provide \$75,000 in funding for the Hike and Bike Trail. The balance left would be \$264,154.63 the CDC approved to fund \$132,076.32.

Motion was made and seconded to approve the Los Fresnos Community Development Corporation action to fund the Hike & Bike Trail Project in the amount of \$132,076.32.

Council member Juan Munoz connected at 6:19 pm. remotely via Zoom.

Mr. Milum explained since the additional funding was approved the council could now approve a contract the bids were discussed on detail at the last council meeting.

Motion was made and seconded to approve the bids and award the contract to Pederson Construction in the amount of \$895,152.63 for the Hike & Bike Trail Project.

### <u>Consideration and ACTION to repair East Sixth Street from Arroyo Boulevard to Pita</u> Street or a portion of the street.Adopted

Mr. Milum explained an issue concerning drainage and pavement along East Sixth Street and Arroyo Blvd. was brought up at the last meeting. The City received a quote to repair half of East Sixth Street. The \$30,000 funds were available to complete the project. Mr. Milum recommended the council approve repairing the entire street which would be an additional \$35,000.

Mr. Milum answered questions from the board and discussed the proposed project.

Motion was made and seconded to approve additional funding in the amount of \$35,000 to repair and re-pave East Sixth Street from Pita Street to Arroyo Blvd in for the total of \$65,000 and use quotes instead of advertised bids.

Mr. Milum explained the widening of Whipple Road progress would take a few years. Mr. Milum feels there is a need for a sidewalk now due to the high use by students walking to and from school. Hanson Engineering provided a price for the engineering services of the sidewalk and have it ready to place for bids. The basic service cost \$43,800 and the special services will cost \$12,600 all capped at \$56,400.
