Mr. Milum explained the non new revenue tax rate is \$0.673087 per \$100 valuation which meant to get the same revenue as last year the tax rate would be \$0.673087 per \$100 valuation instead of our actual rate of \$0.715 per \$100 valuation. The voter approval value \$1.013516 per \$100 valuation is the highest tax rate the City can adopt without holding an election and he was not prospering it be changed. Mayor commented with the current inflation he didn't think it would be good to raise the taxes. Mr. Milum agreed.
