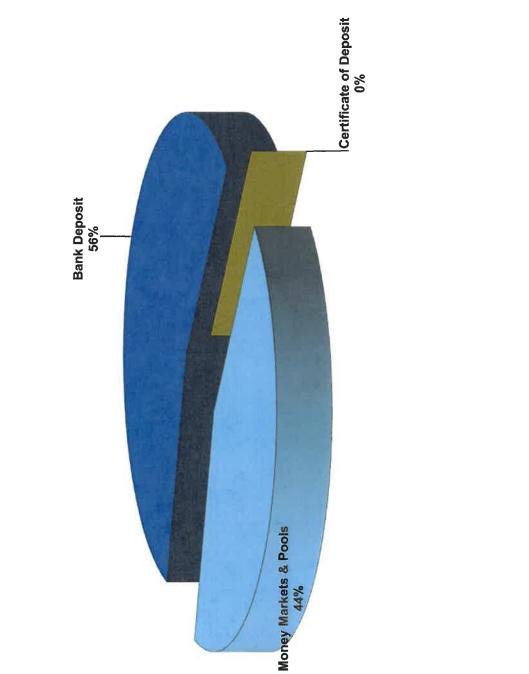

Consideration and ACTION to approve Change Order No. 1 for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Chlorine Contact Basin & Chemical Feed System Improvements.

As work continues on the Chlorine Basin and Chemical Feed System project at the Wastewater Plant, it was determined we can cut the linear feet of pipe that was projected saving \$17,280. It was also determined the need to re-route the electrical duct bank which will add \$47,600. That would be a change order total of \$30,320. If you recall when the bids were accepted for this project, there was excess funds of a little over \$800,000. We used approximated \$50,000 for upgrades to the Headworks Project so funds are still available.

I recommend approval of Change Order #1.

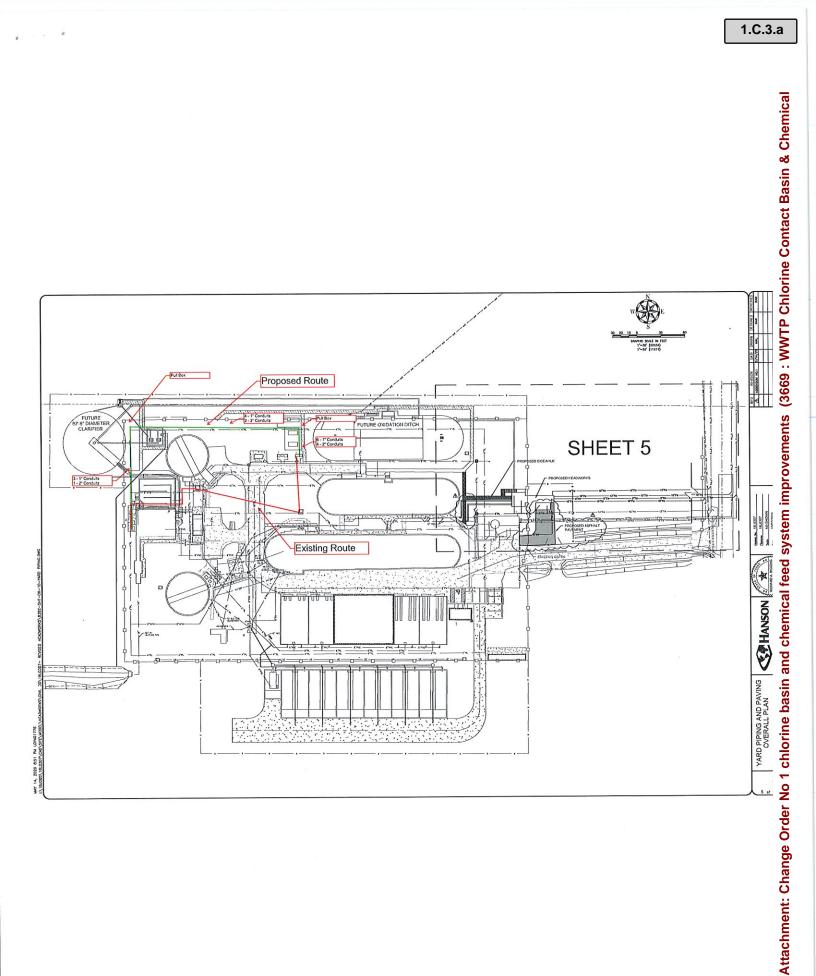

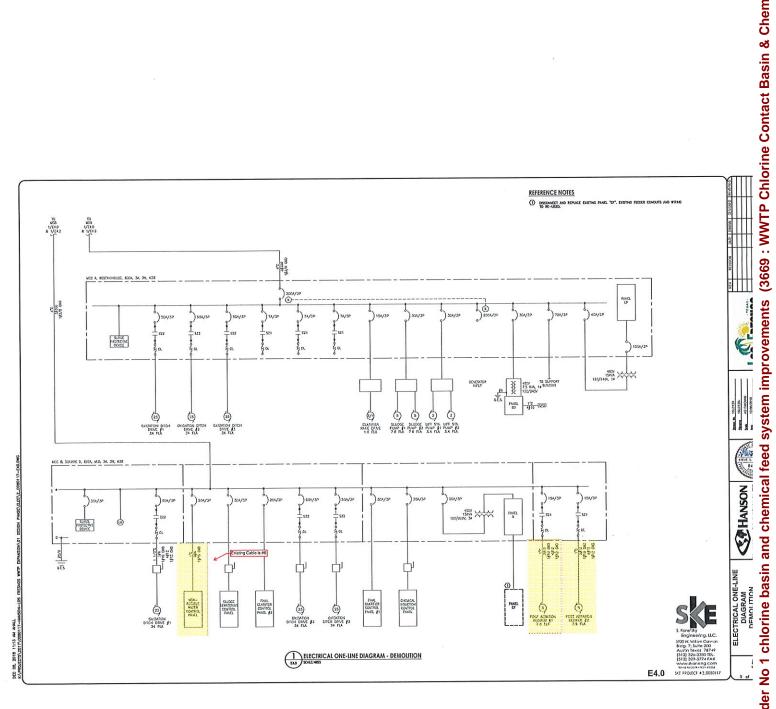

The policy also allows for the city to deviate from it if the city feels it is in the best interest. Additionally, just because there is a tax abatement policy doesn't mean it is automatically approved. The advantages and disadvantages will be considered. This is the same policy that has been in effect for almost 20 years. I believe only 2 businesses have taken advantage of it. The policy is for 2 years.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to promote economic development within the City; and

WHEREAS, the provision of certain economic development incentives may encourage prospective businesses and companies to locate in Los Fresnos or existing businesses and companies to expand; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of specific guidelines, criteria, and procedures are necessary to insure that tax abatement incentives are given and administered effectively; and;

WHEREAS, the adoption of guidelines and criteria are required by State law before an area may be established as a reinvestment zone.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS FRESNOS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Los Fresnos hereby established certain guidelines and criteria governing tax abatement incentives within the City of Los Fresnos and its extraterritorial jurisdiction hereby attached as "Exhibit A", and such guidelines and criteria shall expressly govern all subsequent tax abatement agreements.

SECTION 2. That such guidelines and criteria shall be effective for two (2) years from the date of adoption and may only be amended or repealed by a vote of three-fourths vote of the City Council.

"EXHIBIT A" CITY OF LOS FRESNOS, TEXAS POLICY ON TAX ABATEMENT INCENTIVES

I. <u>PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE</u>

The City of Los Fresnos is committed to the promotion of quality development in all parts of the city and to an on going improvement in the quality of life for its citizens. Insofar as these objectives are generally served by the enhancement and expansion of the local economy, the City of Los Fresnos will, on a case-by-case basis, give consideration to providing tax abatement incentives as stimulation for economic development in Los Fresnos. It is the policy of the City of Los Fresnos that said consideration will be provided in accordance with the procedures and criteria outlined in this document. However, nothing herein shall imply or suggest that the City of Los Fresnos is under obligation to provide any incentive to any applicant. All applicants shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

II. CRITERIA FOR TAX ABATEMENT INCENTIVES

The following threshold criteria shall be used to determine whether any tax abatement incentives shall be granted.

Tax abatements are available to companies that locate within the designated reinvestment zone within the city limits of Los Fresnos. To qualify, the business must:

- (1) be located wholly within the zone
- (2) be making or maintaining a long-term capital investment that increases the taxable value (land, building, equipment) within the zone;
- (3) be committed to creating or retaining two or more jobs;
- (4) be committed, when possible, to hiring local people for new jobs;
- (5) be and remain on the payment of any and all taxes, of any nature, owed to the Federal government, the State of Texas, Cameron County, City of Los Fresnos, and the Los Fresnos Consolidated Independent School District; and
- (6) be able to meet acceptable criteria in such other areas as company leadership, financing, marketing, and planning.

In addition to the minimum requirements stated above, the following subjective criteria shall be considered prior to granting any tax abatement incentive:

- (7) The project meets all relevant zoning requirements.
- (8) Is the project consistent with the comprehensive plan of the City of Los Fresnos?
- (9) What types and cost of public improvements and services (water and sewer main extension, streets, and alleys, etc.) will be required of the City? What types and values of public improvements, if any, will be made by the applicant?

III. <u>TYPES OF INCENTIVES</u>

It is the intent of the City of Los Fresnos to customize the offering of tax abatement incentives on a case-by-case basis. This individualized design is intended to allow maximum flexibility in addressing the unique concerns of each applicant while enabling the City to better respond to the changing needs of the community.

The criteria outlined in Section II above will be used to determine whether it is in the best interest of the City of Los Fresnos to provide any tax abatement incentives to a particular applicant. The degree to which the specified project furthers the goals and objectives of the City of Los Fresnos and the relative impact of the specific project will be used to determine the total value of the tax abatement incentives provided. As a general rule, no tax abatement will be provided to any applicant in an amount exceeding the value of the following:

** Capital investments of \$2,000,000 and up will be considered on the same ratio as the above example as determined by the taxing authorities.

IV. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Any person, organization or corporation desiring that the City of Los Fresnos provide tax abatement incentives to encourage their location or expansion of operations within the city limits or the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Los Fresnos shall be required to comply with the following application procedures. However, nothing within these guidelines shall imply or suggest that the City is under any obligation to provide any incentive to any applicant.

Any applicant desiring tax abatement incentives shall file an application request, which shall include at least the following information:

- (1) A plat showing the precise location of the property, all roadways within 200 feet of the site, and all existing zoning and land uses within 200 feet of the site.
- (2) If the property is described by metes and bounds, a complete legal description should be provided.

- (3) A brief description of the proposed improvements or expansion and its projected cost; the type of business operation proposed; the number and type of jobs created, including information pertaining to anticipated job transfers, the projected date of operation; and the type and value of any economic development incentives requested.
- (4) Any other information about the proposed project as may be required by the City of Los Fresnos or as deemed desirable.

Once the application has been received, the information submitted will be reviewed by the Community Development Staff for completeness and accuracy. The Community Development Board will then ask the Community Development staff for an internal review and comments. Following board review, copies of the complete application package and board comments will be provided to the City Council and to other taxing entities that may be willing to participate in offering tax abatement incentives. Generally, the Community Development Board, staff and applicant will discuss the proposed application at a work session prior to formal consideration by the City Council. Following the work session, the Community Development staff may be requested to obtain other information prior to further consideration of the application.

At a regular City Council meeting, the application for any tax abatement incentive may be considered. The City will comply with certain public notice and hearings that are required as mandated by State law under the Property Redevelopment and Tax Abatement Act prior to the designation of a reinvestment zone and execution of a tax abatement agreement. Prior to final approval, all legal documents to effect such reinvestment zone(s) and tax abatement agreements shall be approved by the City Attorney.

Should the City Council determine that it is in the best interest of the City of Los Fresnos to provide tax abatement incentives to a particular applicant, a resolution shall be adopted declaring that under the guidelines and criteria established herein, the applicant is eligible for tax abatement and that the Mayor is authorized to execute a contract with the applicant, enumerating the type of incentives and governing any conditions applicable to it. Any agreement so adopted must include at least the following specific items:

- (1) Description of the type of tax abatement to be provided and its duration.
- (2) Legal description of the property to be designated as a reinvestment zone.
- (3) Detailed information regarding the type, number, location, and cost of planned improvements.
- (4) A statement granting the access to and inspection of the property and proposed improvements by city inspectors and officials to ensure that the improvements or repairs are made according to specifications and conditions of the agreement.
- (5) A statement limiting the uses of the property consistent with the general purposes of encouraging development or redevelopment of the zone during the period that property tax exemptions are in effect, and

(6) A statement providing for the recapturing of property tax revenue lost as a result of the agreement if the owner of the property fails to make the improvements or repairs as provided by the agreement.

V. AMENDMENTS TO THESE GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

The guidelines and criteria adopted herein shall not be amended or repealed except by three-fourths (3/4) vote of the City Council.

VI. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>

These guidelines and criteria adopted herein shall be effective from the date of passage and remain effective for two (2) years from such date of adoption, unless otherwise repealed by a three-fourths (3/4) vote of the City Council.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE LOS FRESNOS C.I.S.D. POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE LOS FRESNOS POLICE DEPARTMENT

THE STATE OF TEXAS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

COUNTY OF CAMERON '

I. PARTIES

THIS AGREEMENT, is entered into by and between the LOS FRESNOS C.I.S.D. POLICE DEPARTMENT of the State of Texas, and hereinafter referred to as the District Police and the LOS FRESNOS POLICE DEPARTMENT, a city in the County of Cameron, Texas referred to hereinafter as the City Police Department. This agreement and service is entered into under the Interlocal Agreement Act. Any party paying for the performance of any function or service shall make these payments from current revenues available to the paying party.

II.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this agreement is to establish an understanding and cooperation between the District Police and the City Police Department.

The Los Fresnos Consolidated Independent School District (Los Fresnos C.I.S.D.) has established and communicated a policy clearly establishing the parameters of the District Police. The Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. also understands the need to work with law enforcement agencies having overlapping jurisdiction with the Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. Additionally, the City Police Department is equally dedicated to serving the public by coordinating and communicating with the District Police.

111.

AGREEMENT

The City Police Department and the District Police agree to aid each other as may be requested and as each is capable. It is understood that the City Police Department has jurisdiction throughout the City of Los Fresnos and that the District Police have jurisdiction throughout the school district. It is also understood and agreed that the primary responsibility of the District Police will include law enforcement activities within school campus boundaries of the Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. during normal school hours and at other times as may be necessary. The District Police will coordinate after

school hours law enforcement activities with the City Police Department.

In anticipation of the need for the following services; use of the city jail facilities, prisoner transport to the Cameron County Jail (\$2,500), Dispatching Services, TCIC/NCIC, and Call Logging (\$15,000), communication services radio trunking usage – [19 radios @ \$11 monthly] \$2,508 yearly fee, and three (3) City Police Officers at the home varsity football games for six (6) hours (5:30pm - 11:30pm, @ \$30hr x 6hr = \$180 x 3 officers = \$540 x 4 games = \$2,160) \$2,160, Additionally, in anticipation for the need of the use of the training facilities and the gun range the Los Fresnos CISD Police Department agrees to pay the City of Los Fresnos Police Department the amount of two thousand five hundred and no/100ths dollars (\$2,500) annually for the use of these facilities. The total that will be paid to the City of Los Fresnos annually is Twenty-Four thousand, six hundred and sixty eighty and no/100ths dollars (\$24,668.00). These funds will be paid in March of 2021.

IV.

TERM

The term of this agreement shall be for a twelve (12) month period from the date of this agreement. However, either party upon thirty (30) days written notice may terminate without cause this agreement.

V.

INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION

5.1 <u>Governmental Functions</u>. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary herein, this agreement is a contract for and with respect to the performance of governmental functions by governmental entities. The relationship of the City and the District shall be that of independent contractors.

5.2 <u>City Insurance and Indemnification</u>. The Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. shall have no liability whatsoever for the actions of, or failure to act by, any officers, employees, subcontractors, agents or assigns of the City, or for or with respect to this Agreement, and the City covenants and agrees that:

5.2.1 The City shall be solely responsible for and with respect to any claim or cause of action arising out of or with respect to any act, omission or failure to act by the City or its agents, officers, employees and subcontractors, while performing any function or providing or delivering any service undertaken by the City pursuant to this Agreement;

5.2.2 The City shall be solely responsible for procuring and maintaining in effect any insurance coverage it may, in its sole discretion, deem necessary or appropriate to protect its interests.

5.3 <u>District Insurance and Indemnification</u>. The city shall have no liability whatsoever for the actions of, or failure to act by, any officers, employees, subcontractors, agents or assigns of the Los Fresnos C.I.S.D., or for or with respect to the this Agreement by the District, and the District covenants and agrees that:

- 5.3.1 The Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. shall be solely responsible for and with respect to any claim or cause of action arising out of or with respect to any act, omission or failure to act by the Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. or its agents, officers, employees and subcontractors, while performing any function or undertaking any use of the Land and this Agreement;
- 5.3.2 The Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. shall be solely responsible for procuring and maintaining in effect any insurance coverage it may, in its sole discretion, deem necessary or appropriate to protect its interests.

5.4 <u>Governmental Immunity</u>. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to waive, modify or amend any legal defense available at law or in equity to either the City or Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. nor to create any legal rights or claim on behalf of any third party. Neither the Los Fresnos C.I.S.D. nor the City waives, modifies, or alters to any extent whatsoever the availability of the defense of governmental immunity under the laws of the State of Texas. No provision of this agreement is a consent to suit.

VI.

MISCELLANEOUS

6.1 This agreement contains the complete expression of the agreement between the

parties hereto, and there are not promises, representations, agreements, warranties, or inducements except such as are made herein and fully set forth. Any party paying for the performance of any function, services, or improvements to the demised premises shall make these payments from current revenues available to the paying party. No alterations of any of its terms, covenants or conditions shall be binding unless reduced to writing and signed by the parties hereto. It is agreed that all of the rights, remedies, and benefits provided by this agreement shall be cumulative, and shall not be exclusive of any other rights, remedies and benefits allowed by law.

6.2 Nothing herein may be construed as the formation of a partnership, joint venture, or other business organization or any description between the parties.

6.3 In the event one or more of the provisions of this agreement shall for any reason be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of the agreement, and this agreement shall be construed as if the invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been included in the Agreement. This agreement constitutes the sole and only agreement of the Parties to the Agreement and supersedes any prior understanding or written or oral agreements between the Parties respecting the subject matter of this agreement.

6.4 This agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, and all obligations of the parties created by this agreement are performable in Cameron County, Texas.

6.5 No party shall be required to perform any term, condition, or covenant in this agreement so long as performance is delayed or prevented by force majeure, which shall mean acts of God, strikes, lockouts, material or labor restrictions by any governmental authority, floods, and any other cause not reasonably within the control of the parties and which by the exercise of due diligence the parties are unable, wholly or in part, to prevent or overcome.

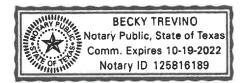

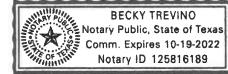

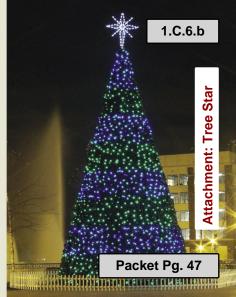

We have funds to cover this amount that were set aside for sewer service to the north side of Whipple Road. We haven't done that project due to not having the easements. I propose we utilize those funds for this and we will work on other funding once we have the easements. Additionally, and more importantly we have worked with the engineer and contractor for some deductions. We will have a maximum of \$73,000 that we can cut from the budget with removing the clearing, grubbing and demolition (city staff can do most of that), remove 1 manhole, reduce the wet well by 3 feet and put the valves above ground instead of underground. A. Wastewater Update - Construction continues on the Chlorrine Contact Basin Project and the Headworks Project. They have 210 days to complete.

The loan for \$1,600,000 for wastewater to fix 3 lift stations, run sewer service to the new annexed areas on West Highway 100, replace some old manholes and replace some old sewer lines has closed. Guzman & Munoz Engineering is working on bid documents so we can go out for bids.

Hanson Professional Services has the documents ready for us to advertise, bid, award contract and begin construction for the Whipple Road Wastewater Extension project. The City has to acquire the easements prior to that.

B. Water Update - The loan for \$3,700,000 for the water plant upgrade and distribution lines has closed. Guzman & Munoz Engineering is working on bid documents so we can go out for bids.

C. Nature Park - Most of the items are done on the Nature Park that we planned to do. For additional work we will have need to get proper funding. The park is looking good.

D. Hike & Bike Trails - Half Associates, engineer and Pederson Construction, contractor, are working on the project. Work began the week of October 19.

E. Henderson Road Project - Construction continues on the Henderson Road Resaca Crossing project. Work is progressing, slowly. Work is expected to be complete by late December.

F. Drainage Update - I have received easements from the owners of Pederson Construction and Community of Christ Church for the drainage ditch behind their properties. I am still waiting on Zarsky Lumber. I discussed with their attorney and they will be sending a proposal. Cameron County Drainage District # 1 will assume maintenance on the ditch to keep it clean. The owner on the north side of that drainage ditch that is the developer for Valle Alto will initially clean the ditch and create a larger detention area. This is all positive for that area. Hanson is working on the several engineering designs for help with drainage along Whipple Road (cost \$100,000) as well as Resaca Escondida (\$300,000). Both will help in poor drainage areas. We are applying for some grants to assist with costs for the construction. We have sent a proposal to TWDB for possible funding for drainage work. Cameron County Drainage District #1 has responded to the Mayor's letter about items of concern that have not been done for several years. They commit to

working with us to get those done but did not offer a time line. We are also working with Cameron County Drainage District #4 on drainage from Henderson Road to Stanford Road along and west of the Railroad Tracks. The work is being done now.

G. 75 Year Anniversary Celebration - Funding for this was not approved with the budget. However, if the Council wishes we can has some kind of press release or something to signify the 75 years. I am open for ideas.

H. Whipple Road - CCRMA continues to work on the overall project of widening of Whipple Road. Hanson Professional Services is working on design to place a sidewalk on one side of the road.

I. CDBG 9th Street Lift Station Grant - This is on the agenda to take action on the bid.

J. Alley Sign Installation - Carlos and his staff will begin installing all the signs. There are a lot of signs. We have been delayed due to Hurricane Hanna, mosquito spraying and other projects. We simply have not had personnel available to work on that. We hope to have them done soon.

K. Boys & Girls Club - Quarterly Report is attached.

We had to re-invent ourselves and are virtually engaging with our members. As part of the Arts program, our members participated in different arts and crafts activities that enhanced their creativity by using daily household items along with regular school supplies. Our Arts and Crafts instructor applied herself to keep members interested and wanting to come back for more projects.

The Club distribute meals provided by the Boys and Girls Club of Texas Alliance thru their Summer Food Service Program. Although we stopped for a brief time, midway thru June due to the increase in COVID-19 cases in our area. We picked up again in July serving an average of 175 meals per week all thru mid-August.

The first two weeks of July, the Club had a Coding camp thru our partners, Sylvan Rio Grande Valley and the Texas Alliance of the Boys and Girls Club. Additionally, part of our virtual summer was different lessons type video sessions that ranged from health and nutrition, physical activities and simple exercises that could take place in the members' living room.

As the summer came to an end, and the uncertainty of the near future remains, members return to school virtually. As we await what will come next, the Club started serving over 50 Grab-n-Go meals a day to our members over a 14-mile radius in September.

City funds allowed the Club not only to provide summer arts & crafts activities and other virtual activities but to stay operational since our main source of income is Summer, After School, and Sports program fees along with Food Program reimbursements. The Club served 80 members between virtual sessions and meals. As part of the Boys & Girls Club Experience, members are offered virtual lessons and activities to keep their minds occupied and engaged.

Goals and Outcomes of these programs:

Tutoring (fall session):

Goal: Club members have access virtual tutoring thru our partner Sylvan Learning thru Texas Alliance of Boys & Girls Club

Outcome: Club members have a safe on-line place to go and interact with friends and club staff. Members needing assistance will be identified and parents notified of tutoring opportunities.

Sports & Fitness:

Goal: Club members learn new, fun activities to keep them fit and make healthy lifestyle choices. **Outcome:** Club members are participating in regular physical activity thru our virtual lessons. These lessons develop our members' capacity to engage in positive behaviors to nurture their well-being, set personal goals and grow into self-sufficient adults. 3:03 PM

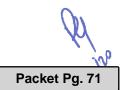

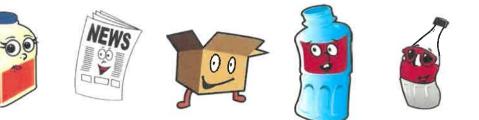
