#### REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2014

The Los Fresnos City Council convened in a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, November 18, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall, 200 N. Brazil Street. Present were Mayor Polo Narvaez, Mayor Protem Yolanda H. Cruz, Councilmember Swain Real, Councilmember Tom Jones, and Councilmember Gary Minton. Also present were City Manager Mark W. Milum, City Engineer Anna Smith and City Secretary Pam Denny. Councilmember Javier Mendez arrived at 7:21 p.m.

Mayor Narvaez called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

#### **Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance**

Mayor Narvaez gave the invocation and led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **Oath of Office**

Judge Carlos Cascos sworn into office Polo Narvaez as Mayor and Yolanda H. Cruz as Councilmember Place 1.

#### **Recess Meeting**

Mayor Narvaez recessed the meeting for refreshments at 7:08 p.m.

#### Call Meeting back to Order

Mayor Narvaez called the meeting back to order at 7:15 p.m.

#### Consideration and ACTION of the Consent Agenda.

- 1. Approval or rejection of Minutes from October 14, 2014 meeting.
- 2. Approval or rejection of a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Los Fresnos Police Department and the Los Fresnos Consolidated Independent School District Police Department.
- 3. Approval or rejection of a Resolution approving the Investment Policy and Strategies for fiscal year 2014-2015.
- 4. Approval or rejection on the reappointment of Gene Daniels as Municipal Judge for a three year term.

Councilmember Jones made a motion to approve consent agenda as presented, seconded by Councilmember Real and the vote for approval was 5-0.

# <u>Visitor remarks – To speak you must sign in prior to the meeting and you will have a limit</u> of 3 minutes to speak.

There were no comments.

#### <u>Public hearing to receive comments from the public on the rezoning of 3.50 acres and 9.944</u> acres from R-1 Single Family District to C-2 Highway Commercial District and to rezone 10.00 acres from R-1 Single Family District to PUD Planned Unit Development.

Mayor Narvaez opened the public hearing at 7:17 p.m.

Mr. Milum explained where the property was located. He stated that anytime property is annexed into the city it comes in as single family residential then zoning has to be changed to fit the land use.

There were no comments from the public.

Mayor Narvaez closed the public hearing at 7:19 p.m.

<u>Consideration and ACTION to approve a Resolution relating to establishing the City's</u> <u>intention to reimburse itself for the prior lawful expenditure of funds relating to</u> <u>constructing various city improvements from the proceeds of tax-exempt obligations to be</u> <u>issued by the City for authorized purposes; authorizing other matters incident and related</u> <u>thereto; and providing an effective date.</u>

Mr. Milum stated that this resolution will allow the City to start the process on the improvements prior to the closing which will be in January. This will give us a couple of month's head start.

Councilmember Real made a motion to approve and adopt a Resolution relating to establishing the City's intention to reimburse itself for the prior lawful expenditure of funds relating to constructing various city improvements from the proceeds of tax-exempt obligations to be issued by the City for authorized purposes; authorizing other matters incident and related thereto; and providing an effective date, seconded by Councilmember Jones and the vote for approval was unanimous.

<u>Consideration and ACTION to approve a Resolution by the City Council of the City of Los</u> <u>Fresnos, Texas authorizing and approving publication of Notice of Intention to issue</u> <u>Certificates of Obligation; complying with the requirements contained in Securities and</u> <u>Exchange Commission rule 15c-12; and providing an effective date.</u>

Mr. Milum stated that this is the Texas Water Development Board loan and loan forgiveness that was approved a few months ago. This is a required notice that must be published.

Mayor Narvaez made a motion to approve a Resolution by the City Council of the City of Los Fresnos, Texas authorizing and approving publication of Notice of Intention to issue Certificates of Obligation; complying with the requirements contained in Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 15c-12; and providing an effective date, seconded by Councilmember Mendez and the vote for approval was unanimous.

#### <u>Consideration and ACTION to approve a service agreement between the City of Los</u> <u>Fresnos and Cameron County Fair and Livestock Show.</u>

Mr. Milum stated that the City has utilized Hotel/Motel Tax for assisting the Cameron County Fair & Livestock Show. Last year the Council approved \$3,500.

Ms. Valerie Arizmendi, President of the CCFLS, was present and stated that last year there was over 450 animals, 100 home show entries and they gave out 5 scholarships. This will be the35th year of the Cameron County Fair & Livestock Show.

Ms. Sherilyn Goad, Treasurer, stated the Cameron County Farm Bureau is sponsoring a program called Kids Cows and More. The program will start will 3<sup>rd</sup> graders in Cameron County and the program will teach them about agriculture.

Mr. Milum and Ms. Arizmendi answered questions from the Council.

Mayor Pro-tem Cruz made a motion to approve \$4,500 service agreement with Cameron County Fair & Livestock Show, seconded by Councilmember Minton and the vote for approval was unanimous.

#### <u>Consideration and ACTION to approve a service agreement between the City of Los</u> <u>Fresnos and Los Fresnos Rodeo Committee.</u>

Mr. Milum stated that the City has utilized Hotel/Motel Tax for assisting the Rodeo. Last year the Council approved \$2,500 for social media promotion and \$10,000 for sponsor.

Mr. Mike Todd, Chairman of the Rodeo Committee, was present and he handed out information to the Council. Mr. Todd explained that the Rodeo Committee is again requesting the City to be a platinum sponsor for \$10,000. This year they need to have more advertising on the radio and television and the amount of that sponsor is \$1,500. Mr. Todd stated that Josh Abbott will be performing for the concert.

Mr. Todd answered questions from the Council.

Councilmember Mendez made a motion to approve \$11,500 service agreement with the Los Fresnos Rodeo Committee, seconded by Councilmember Minton and the vote for approval was unanimous.

#### Consideration and ACTION to approve the first reading of Ordinance 235-EE to rezone 3.50 acres and 9.944 acres from R-1 Single Family District to C-2 Highway Commercial District and to rezone 10.00 acres from R-1 Single Family District to PUD Planned Unit Development District.

Mr. Milum stated that the public hearing was held earlier. The Planning and Zoning approved the rezoning at their meeting on Monday.

Councilmember Real stated he would not discuss or vote on this item.

Mr. Milum stated that the City property and the Fire Department and EMS property needs to be zoned as a C-2 Highway Commercial District for our needs. The property owned by Alamo Street Development is requesting to be zoned as Planned Unit Development District which allows for a mix of commercial and residential type development.

Councilmember Mendez made a motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance 235-EE to rezone 3.50 acres and 9.944 acres from R-1 Single Family District to C-2 Highway Commercial District and to rezone 10.00 acres from R-1 Single Family District to PUD Planned Unit Development District, seconded by Councilmember Minton and the vote for approval was 5-0 with Councilmember Real not voting. Motion passed.

#### <u>Consideration and ACTION to reappoint and appoint members to the Planning and</u> <u>Zoning Commission.</u>

#### <u>Consideration and ACTION to appoint a new member to the Los Fresnos Community</u> <u>Development Corporation.</u>

Mr. Mendez stated that he had turned in a citizen application for Mr. Robert Lopez a few months back and Mr. Lopez is still interested.

Mayor Narvaez made a motion to appoint Mr. Robert Lopez to the CDC Board, seconded by Councilmember Mendez and the vote for approval was unanimous.

#### Update by City Manager

- A. <u>Wastewater Plant Expansion</u> We are still waiting approval from TCEQ. Then TWDB will be able to give us final approval to start the bidding process.
- B. <u>Raw Water Line Upgrade, Filter Replacement, and Sludge Removal System</u> Work continues. Due to an alignment problem that has been worked out work was delayed and of course there has been weather days. The project should be completed by December. Filter Replacement work is occurring at the contractors shop. The contractor asked for an extension to the end of December which we agreed with. Sludge Removal System Quite a bit of work has been done on site. Construction will be completed shortly after the Filter Replacement Project is complete.
- C. <u>**Development Projects**</u> Paseo Point Apartments is scheduled to be complete by the end of the year. Walmart says they will open on March 19.
- D. <u>Community Park Parking</u> The work is complete and the parking lot is open. However the asphalt did not meet the thickness requirements so we are working with the County to determine the solution. The parking area on Nogal Street and Third Street is in the approval process.
- E. <u>Los Fresnos Nature Park</u> We have finally made the purchase for the 21 acres for the Nature Park. We are now the owners. I have sent another letter concerning the other 2.1 acres giving them until December 12 to make a decision. At that time we will either purchase the property or request moving the left over money to begin design and work.
- F. <u>Hazardous Mitigation Plan</u> Mr. Milum was notified that the grant has been approved on the state level and is being sent to the federal level for approval. We have not heard any more information.
- G. <u>Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Projects</u> This is funding from TxDOT through the Brownsville MPO for trails, sidewalks and similar projects. We submitted 4 projects. 1. Sidewalks on both side of S Arroyo Boulevard from Alvarez Court to Ocean Boulevard. 2. Sidewalk on the west side of N. Arroyo Boulevard from First Street to Henderson Road. 3. Sidewalk on the south side of Ocean Boulevard from about Church's Chicken to Tapia's Café. 4. Hike & Bike Trail around town utilizing the existing canals and drainage ditches. Project 1 and 3 were approved for funding. I do not know when the funding will be available yet but it should be within the next 6 months.
- H. <u>CDBG Grant</u> G & T Paving has completed the reconstruction of the Ebony, Pecan, and Magnolia Streets. They just have some driveways and cleanup work to do. They are just about complete with the drainage in the same area. They still have the lift station work to do on the South Arroyo Lift Station.

I. <u>Certificates of Obligations</u> – 1. Lopez Lift Station – Engineering is ongoing to be completed the end of November so we can bid the project. It looks like we will have to include replacement of the force main from the lift station to the plant because the current line is too small. 2. Water Loop – Engineering is ongoing to be completed the end of November so we can bid the project. 3. Evergreen Street – Engineering is ongoing to be completed the end of November so we can bid the project. We also need to settle the street right-of-way. 4. Architect & Design of City Hall – I hope to get something out in the next few weeks. 5. Engineering for Sewer Extension, West, Sewer Extension Escalante Road and Sewer Extension Whipple Road – Will work on this in the spring as some might be able to be covered by existing grants. 6. Purchase of Land – Completed.

## **BASKETBALL PROGRAM**

#### Program or Initiative Name: Boys and Girls Club of Los Fresnos (Club) Basketball Leagues

**Need Statement:** The community of Los Fresnos, Texas located in Cameron County has a population of 6,219 according to 2013 US Census estimates. Additionally, the Los Fresnos Consolidated School District boasts a student population of nearly 10,000 students. Although many of these students live outside of Los Fresnos they do live within Cameron County and have the opportunity to participate in Boys and Girls Club of Los Fresnos activities through membership.

Approximately thirty-five percent of the Cameron County population lives under the federal poverty level-double that of the thirty four percent of State of Texas families living under the same measurement. According to the Center on Children and Families at Brookings Institution, a child's school readiness can be greatly impacted by poverty. In example, higher levels of depression and a more punitive parenting style, for example, may result from economic stress and so models controlling for these factors may understate the full effects of poverty on school readiness.

The Club seeks to provide the opportunity of competing in basketball league play to approximately 300 Los Fresnos area at-risk youth who can benefit from hard work, fairness, leadership, life skills, responsibility, and achieving personal goals in addition to game skills. Participation in organized sports programs has been shown to help build healthier, stronger bodies and also curb anxiety and aggression levels in children. Additionally, participants are taught to accept and follow instructions and block out distractions while engaged in working toward a goal.

#### **Program Outcomes:**

Goal 1. Provide Los Fresnos area youth the opportunity to join and participate in Boys and Girls Club of Los Fresnos Spring 2015 Basketball League play.

•Ninety-five percent of league participants will gain basic fundamentals of basketball league play.

•Ninety-five percent of league participants will complete the season and continue participating in Boys and Girls Club of Los Fresnos activities through the remainder of the 2014 fiscal year-July 2014.

Goal 2. Los Fresnos area youth will gain additional benefits through participation in the Boys and Girls Club of Los Fresnos Spring 2015 Basketball League play.

•Ninety-five percent of league participants will maintain or reduce their BMI.

•Ninety-five percent of league participants will not receive any discipline referrals at their respective campus.

•Ninety-five percent of league participants will maintain or increase academic performance in their student progress report cards.

#### **Discussion on CDBG Projects.**

Every 2 years funds area available through the Community Development Block Grant program. The 15 small entities in this area have a gentleman's agreement to share these funds equally amount each other. The amounts continue to decline as federal funds are cut. This cycle there will be approximately \$250,000 available. Scoring on the projects is done to determine which projects get funded first. Higher priority (points) goes to water and wastewater projects. The next highest priority goes to emergency services, drainage and street projects. Sidewalks, trails, and buildings do not get many points. The last cycle we did 3 streets (Ebony, Pecan, Magnolia), drainage along the canal in the same area of the streets and rehabilitation of a lift station. ### Update by City Manager A. Wastewater Plant Expansion B. Raw Water Line Upgrade, Filter Replacement, Sludge Removal C. Development Projects - Paseo Pointe Apartments, Walmart D. Los Fresnos Nature Park E. Hazardous Mitigation Plan F. CDBG Project G. Certificates of Obligation

A. Wastewater Plant Expansion - We are still waiting on approval from TCEQ. Then TWDB will be able to give us final approval to start the bidding process.

B. Raw Water Line Upgrade - Work continues. Due to wet weather the work has had some delays. The final connection is all that is lacking. The project should be completed by the end of December. Filter Replacement - Work is occurring at the contractors shop with the filters scheduled to be delivered to the water plan on Monday. Once it is there final preparations will be made for the installation. We will receive all of our water for consumption from SRWA during this time when the entire plant will be down. The project should be completed by the end of December. Sludge Removal System - Quite a bit of work has been done on site. Construction will be completed shortly after the Filter Replacement project is complete by the end of December.

C. Development Projects - Paseo Point Apartments is scheduled to be complete by the end of the year. Wal-Mart says they will open on March 19.

D. Los Fresnos Nature Park - We have finally made the purchase for the 21 acres for the Nautre Park. We are now the owners. The owner of the remaining 2.1 acres still wants 2 times the value of the land. I will be make a request to move the remaining funds to begin a master design plan and possible some work. There is \$154,242.60 in remaining funds.

E. Hazardous Mitigation Plan - I was notified that the grant has been approved on the state level and is sent to the federal level for approval. We have not heard any more information.

F. CDBG Grant - G & T Paving has completed the reconstruction of the 3 streets, Ebony, Pecan and Magnolia, the drainage and the lift station work. We will have a final walk through to assure all is complete. We will hold a public hearing on the completion in our January meeting.

G. Certificates of Obligations - 1. Lopez Lift Station - Engineering is ongoing to be completed the end of December so we can bid the project. It looks like we will have to include replacement of the force main from the lift station to the plant because the current line is too small. 2. Water Loop - Engineering is ongoing to be completed the end of December so we can bid the project. There is a chance we can get this funded through TWDB. If we can this will free these funds for something else. 3. Evergreen Street - Engineering is ongoing to be completed the street ROW. 4. Architect & Design of City Hall - I hope to get something out in the next few weeks. 5. Engineering for Sewer Extension West, Sewer Extension Escalante Road & Sewer Extension Whipple Road - Will work on this in the spring as some might be able to be covered by existing grants. 6. Purchase of Land - Completed.
