WHEREAS, COVID-19 (coronavirus) is a contagious respiratory virus; and		
WUFDEAS COVID 10 has been declared a pendemic by the World Health Organization, and		

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has been declared a pandemic by the World Health Organization; and

WHEREAS, the United States Federal Government declared a national emergency on March 13, 2020 due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Governor Abbot declared a State of Disaster in Texas on March 13, 2020, due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to take additional steps to prepare for, respond to and mitigate the spread of COVID-19 to protect public health and welfare,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR OF LOS FRESNOS, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That a local state of disaster was hereby declared on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, for the City of Los Fresnos, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the local state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Commission of Los Fresnos, Texas

- 3. Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
- 4. Pursuant to §418.018 (d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan and all procedures and authority vested in the Emergency Management Office are hereby invoked.
- 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
