

The City of Los Fresnos continues to actively monitor the Coronavirus Disease 2019 called COVID-19 situation in conjunction with local, state and federal authorities. As we deliver services to the residents of Los Fresnos, safety for our staff and residents will drive our decision making. The constant media coverage and the cancellation of so many events and activities can be overwhelming and cause panic. However, the ultimate goal is to reduce the spread of COVID-19 and all actions should be focused with that in mind.

Information and response to COVID-19 is changing rapidly day to day and sometimes from one moment to the next. Health officials have recommended all citizens take basic preventative measures to protect against COVID-19 and most importantly take action to prevent further spread. Included actions are as follows:

- Wash hand with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Use hand sanitizer in absence of washing hands with soap and water.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover you coughs or sneezes with a tissue and then discard the tissue.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- Avoid close contact with those who are sick.
- Stay at home when you are sick and contact your doctor if needed.
- People who are well do not need to wear masks at home or in public.
- Reduce public contact where possible.

In an effort to stop this spread the City will implement the following:

- Utilize on line pay and auto pay (cityoflosfresnos.com)
- Utilize the drive thru lanes for payment or dropping off documents
- Utilize the night deposit box for payment or dropping off documents
- Utilize phone or email to handle as much business as possible
- Contact Court Clerk concerning citations as many can be resolved without coming to Court
- Library computer lab is suspended
- Citizen finger printing is suspended
- Senior Citizen Program will close until March 23
- Boys & Girls Club will close until March 23
- Little League Baseball has suspended practice and beginning of play until at least April 6
- Increase sanitizing of city property including parks
