WARRANT INFORMATION

Issuing a Warrant

The Court may issue a warrant when:

- You do not complete a payment plan or fail to make payment as promised.
- You fail to appear.
- You fail to comply with an order of the Court.

Failure to Appear

If you fail to appear on or before the appearance date for your citation, a violation of failure to appear/violate promise to appear may be filed against you. In addition, the Court may:

- Issue a warrant for your arrest
- Add additional fees per violation
- Place a hold on your driver's license renewal
- Place a hold on vehicle registration renewal

Failure to Meet An Order of the Court

If you have appeared before a Judge and have agreed to a payment plan, community service or other judicial orders, you must complete these orders as specified or a warrant may be issued for your arrest.

Resolving Your Violation

Your warrant may be canceled by pleading "no contest" or "guilty" to the violation(s) and making payment for the fine(s).

Cash Bond

This money must be paid in the form of cash, cashier's check or money order (credit cards are not accepted as payment for cash bonds). You will receive receipt of your cash bond which will indicate a court date.
